


# Denny Station at Westlake (DT-1)











# Denny Station at Terry (DT-2 & SLU Mix-and-Match)

#### Motion No. M2023-18

Denny Station: While the previously-identified preferred alternative is not modified at this time, staff is directed to carry forward both the Denny Station on Westlake (DT1) Draft EIS Station alternative and Denny Station on Terry (i.e. South Lake Union Mix and Match) alternative as part of ongoing environmental review. Staff is directed to continue collaboration with City of Seattle and community partners to further clarify the technical, financial, schedule and risk implications of both alternatives and return to the Board with a status report by May 25, 2023.

For the Denny Station on Westlake alternative, staff is directed to include a station entrance location within 8th Avenue right-of-way and should also explore potential refinements to minimize closure of Westlake Avenue.

For the Denny Station on Terry (South Lake Union: Mix-and-Match) alternative, staff is directed to include station access from both sides of Denny Way.

## Work Underway

### Denny Station at Terry (SLU Mix-and-Match)

- 1. Further clarify the technical, financial, schedule and risk implications of constructing the station box with:
  - a. Relocating Fiber out of Terry Ave ROW
  - b. Maintaining Fiber in Terry Ave ROW
- 2. Further clarify the other (non-fiber related) cost and schedule implications of the SLU Mix-and-match concept

#### **Fiber**

- 1. Understanding the utility and interrelationship among:
  - a. Long Haul Fiber within Terry Ave ROW
  - b. Local/Metro Fiber within Terry Ave ROW
  - c. Data center adjacent to Terry Ave
- 2. Understanding technical, financial, schedule and risk implication of
  - Relocating Fiber out of Terry Ave ROW
  - b. Maintaining Fiber in Terry Ave ROW

#### Denny Station at Westlake

- 1. Can impacts to Westlake be further reduced?
- 2. Can the Westlake sewer be replaced and maintained?
- 3. What are the technical, financial, schedule and risk implications of ideas to further reduce impacts? And how do they affect the entire Ballard Link Extension delivery timeline?
